Through partnerships and contracting with council and waste management companies, Outlook Environmental runs innovative, state-of-the-art waste transfer stations and recycle shops at Mornington, Knox, Pakenham, Hampton Park and Reservoir and a nursery Pakenham to provide jobs and vocational training for disadvantaged workers.

### **Incito Maintenance 3:45pm - 4:30pm**

The third social enterprise started by WISE Employment, Incito Maintenance delivers a range of general carpentry, 'handyperson', gardening and cleaning services within a 50km radius of Melbourne's CBD. It has dual purpose of providing meaningful work with real wages for people with a mental illness or other disability, and disadvantaged members of our community, and they actively recruit tenants of social and public housing.
